Atlantis Dumaguete Resort is located in Dauin on Negros Island, the third largest island in the Philippines. Surrounded by an amazing tropical garden with some of the rarest plants to be found in the Philippines. The resort again received the tripadvisor Certificate of Excellence in 2019 for good reason.

You'll book your own air into Manila, then connect to your flight to Dumaguete. The best way to do this is on Philippine Airlines all the way, as your bags will go with you and not be subject to additional fees on the smaller plane between the islands.

Toko's restaurant provides 3 meals a day using fresh local products and flavors, but made to an international standard. You'll find daily changing blackboard menus at both lunch and dinner, plus an extensive list of cocktails and shakes.

There are dozens of dive sites and short boat rides....except if/when we take a day to head out to an outer island. A dive day is included to Apo Island (or other, depending on weather and currents). The dive operation is rated PADI 5* of which only 2 exist in the Philippines. Many PADI courses for all levels are offered if you wish to improve your skills. A non-diver might want to try a "Discover Scuba" course. Note that Nitrox is included free, a \$270 value offered with this DEMA special.

This archipelago is home to more than 3000 species of fish and 448 species of coral. AND, where else can you combine unbelievable muck diving with pristine coral reefs and shoals of schooling fish.
