Anthony's Key, the resort that nature designed, is located on the lush tropical island of Roatan. In addition to its proximity to some of the best dive and snorkel sites in the Caribbean on the second largest barrier reef in the world, the resort plays host to one of the world's most unique centers the Roatan Institute for Marine Sciences. For an extra charge, visitors can interact with the Institute's dolphins in their natural habitat. Snorkelers can swim with the dolphins; certified divers can observe and interact with them in the open ocean. With air temps about 85, water temps over 80, and visibility of 80-100 ft, this is one of our club's favorite destinations for divers and non-divers alike.

Families love AKR. Check out the resort website and learn about their SCUBA and Dolphin camps for kids. Four days with instructors while mom or grandma does her own thing! Little ones 5-9 will love the dolphin interactions; kids 10-14 may become Junior SCUBA certified at the end of the week. Extra charge, of course, but your kids and grandkids will have a week they never forget.

Dive package includes 3 single tank boat dives per day (6 days) plus 2 single tank night dives and a Buoyancy Control Workshop. Enjoy free shore diving during shop hours. We have the best and biggest rooms, all on the island. Snorkel package includes 2 daily guided snorkels by boat (6 days) and 1 night snorkel by boat, also with a guide. One dolphin encounter, a reef ecology lecture with fish ID show and an underwater fish ID card are included with the snorkel package. Divers must carry dive accident insurance.
